#### Directions:

From I-4 heading East: Take exit #86 Par St. (right exit); turn left onto Par. Continue 0.2 mile to Formosa. Right on Formosa, then first left into parking lot. Park and enter at the rear of the building, which is at the corner of Formosa & Par.

From I-4 heading West: Take exit #87 Fairbanks Ave. (right exit). Turn left onto Fairbanks Ave. Continue for 0.3 mile and turn right onto Formosa Ave. Note that in 0.25 miles. Formosa takes a sharp right and then a sharp left to go under I-4; then continue about 0.4 mile to the parking lot on the right, just before the traffic light. Park and enter at the rear of the building, which is on the corner of Formosa & Par.
